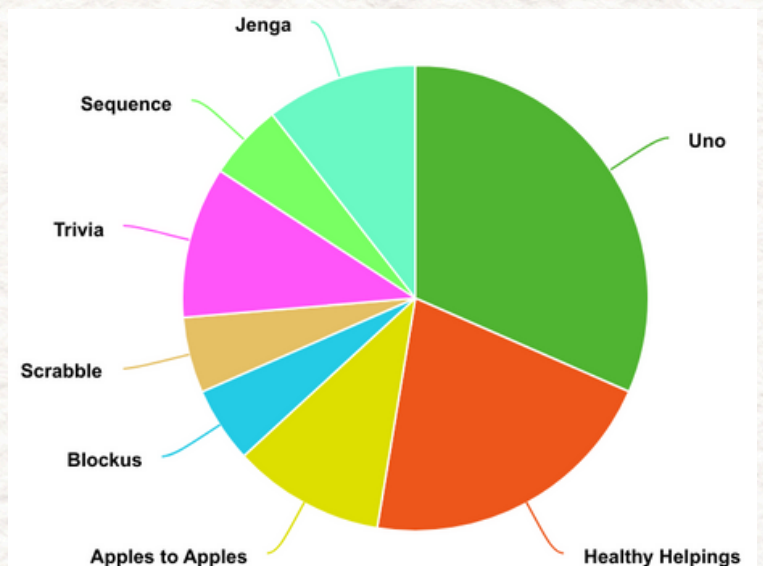
Fostering Lasting Friendships
